HOW TO GET THERE?

Louvain-la-Neuve (not to be confused with Louvain, the French version of Leuven)

BY CAR OR COACH

GPS coordinates to the front door:

50°40'16.42"N

4°36'45.28"E

Altitude: 119 m

Enter Boulevard du Nord (the former street name) rather than Rue du Labrador, as the latter reference has not yet been incorporated into all GPS networks.

From Brussels or Namur

Take the motorway E411 towards Namur if you are coming from Brussels, and towards Brussels if you are coming from Namur. Take exit 8a, and at the first roundabout go straight towards Louvain-la-Neuve.

As you arrive in the tunnel, take a right at the first junction. Drive underneath the museum and take a right for free parking, or left for paid parking on the Grand Place (main square).

From Waterloo

Take the Chaussée de Charleroi (N5) towards Genappe. Before arriving at Genappe,

take the N25 towards Louvain-la-Neuve. Take a left (N4) at the roundabout towards Ottignies/Louvain-la-Neuve. At the third roundabout, take a left towards the centre of Louvain-la-Neuve (Esplanade). As you arrive in the tunnel, take a right at the first junction. Drive underneath the museum and take a right for free parking, or left for paid parking on the Grand Place (main square).

From Brussels airport

Take the ring road and follow the direction E411 to Namur (Namen) – Luxembourg. On the E411 motorway to Namur, take exit 8a, and at the first roundabout go straight towards Louvain-la-Neuve. As you arrive in the tunnel, take a right at the first junction. Drive underneath the museum and take a right for free parking, or left for paid parking on the Grand Place (main square).

From Charleroi Airport

Take the north-east direction and then veer to the right towards Rue de Ransart. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Rue de Ransart, then turn right to stay on Rue de Ransart. Continue on to Rue Léon Baras. At the roundabout take the 1st exit

towards Liège/Luik/Bruxelles. Join the A15/E42 by the slip road towards Liège/Namur. Take the exit for Dausoulx to join the A4/E411 towards Brussels. Take exit 8a to Louvain-la-Neuve via the N4, and at the first roundabout go straight ahead towards Louvain-la-Neuve. As you arrive in the tunnel, take a right at the first junction. Drive underneath the museum and take a right for free parking, or left for paid parking on the Grand Place (main square).

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

> BY RAIL

The Louvain-la-Neuve – Université station is directly linked to the junction of Ottignies, located on the Brussels-Namur line, with two trains an hour in each direction, including at weekends. Louvain-la-Neuve (not to be confused with Louvain, the French version of Leuven) can be reached in 30 minutes from Brussels, sometimes without changing trains.

From Namur or Charleroi

Coming from Namur or Charleroi, you need to change at Ottignies and take the train to Louvain-la-Neuve.

From Luxembourg

Coming from Luxembourg, get off at Ottignies (if you are on the EC 96 Iris or the EC 90 Vauban coming from Switzerland, you should change at Namur) and take the train to Louvain-la-Neuve.

From other countries

If you are coming from abroad, get off at Bruxelles-Nord if your train goes through this station. Otherwise get off at Bruxelles-Midi, point of departure for all trains to Ottignies via Bruxelles-Central, Bruxelles-Nord, Bruxelles-Schuman and Bruxelles-Luxembourg (previously known as Bruxelles-Quartier Léopold). Then take the train to Louvain-la-Neuve.

From Bruxelles-Midi

If arriving at Bruxelles-Midi on the Thalys or Eurostar, take the Namur–Luxembourg train, stopping in Ottignies. In Ottignies, take the train to Louvain-la-Neuve. *Timetables are available on the website www.sncb.be or by telephoning +32 (0)2 528 28 28*

From Brussels Airport - Zaventem

Arriving at Brussels Airport (Zaventem), you can get to Louvain-la-Neuve by train

> BY BUS

Several TEC buses run from the Louvain-la-Neuve bus station to:

Brussels

Route C2 or Conforto Bis travelling to Brucargo (Zaventem) via Diegem, underground stations Rodebeek and Crainhem (UCL Brussels University) and Wavre SNCB (railway) station.

Etterbeek

Route C or Conforto via the Plaine des Manœuvres, Etterbeek SNCB station, Delta Metro and Wavre SNCB station.

Jodoigne

Rapido Bus 1
via Thorembais-Saint-Trond

Waterloo

Rapido Bus 3 via Braine-l'Alleud, Ohain, Lasne and Céroux

Nivelles

SNCB station (Rapido Bus 4)
via Genappe and Beauvieux
